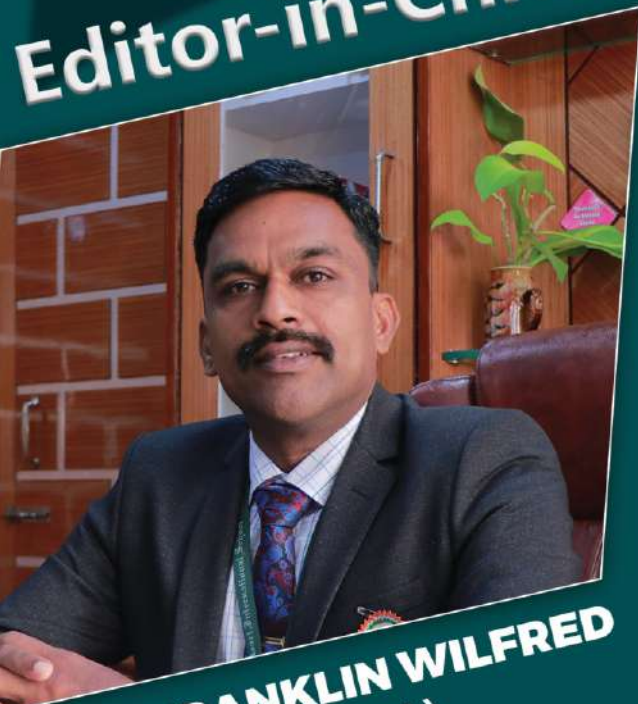

Family members started playing in sea and we spent nearly an hour playing in waves. Writing the names on sand was an unforgettable wonderful moment.

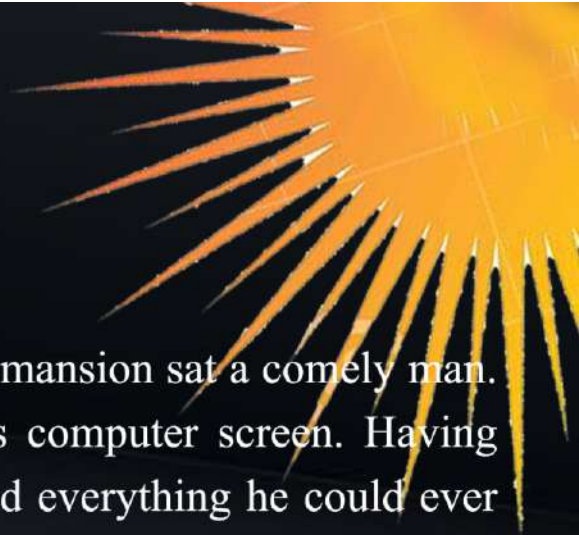
Shopping:
